

An M.Tech. student can change his/her program, if permitted, to Ph.D. and continue to do the course/research work to enable him/her to meet the requirements of the Ph.D. degree.

Only students with CGPA >8.00 and who have completed minimum of 2 semesters and 20 credits in M.Tech. program will be eligible to apply for the change to Ph.D. program.

The student will be eligible for Ph.D. stipend only from the time he/she is approved for enrollment as the Ph.D. student. Such a student, for Ph.D. credit requirement, may be treated as if he/she had joined the Ph.D. program from the start of the PG (here, M.Tech.) program.

The student may be granted an M.Tech. degree also, provided he/she fulfils all the academic requirements for the same. Such a student may also be refunded his/her M.Tech. tuition fee, if he/she successfully completes the Ph.D. program.
