1. Confirmation of the minutes of the 27th meeting of the PGC held on 24th Jan, 2018.

 - If the CGPA falls below 6.00, the student may be placed under warning first, and if the performance does not improve, he may be asked to leave the program."
 - However, as per the current CGPA formula (i.e. the count of "F" towards CGPA is NIL), the students with even 4 "F" grades in a semester are not getting any warning.
 - Hence the criteria for Academic Warning need to be looked into.

- 7. To discuss about timeline for submission of list of students who are going for internship by Placement office to Academic section.
