Following a detailed discussion, the AAC decided that a full-time Professor of Practice (PoP) would now be permitted to oversee the ENT BTP track. There will be no other change in BTP guidelines. _	Request for Course Credit Waiver for Sandeep Sharma (8 Credits)
5.	The above proposal has been deliberated within the AAC, and the committee approved the proposal for the waiver of 8 credits of coursework for Sandeep Sharma. He has done 106 credits of coursework and 33 credits of thesis work at IIT BHU prior to joining IIITD. Acknowledging the quality of the Institute and the coursework done by the student, the committee approved the request as a special case as per PG regulation <u>16.2.(b)</u> .

6.	<u>Request for Transfer of Credits - Winter Semester 2024 at IIT Roorkee -</u> <u>Rohit Aggarwal (2019474) B Tech CSAI, 8th Semester</u>
	The AAC thoroughly discussed and noted that as per the UG regulation 6.7, the student may do academic work and courses in places of repute outside IIIT-Delhi and may be allowed to spend up to 2 semesters at another University.
	Dr. Jainendra informed the AAC, that the case was discussed in the department and the department was satisfied with the courses which the student is going to opt in IIT Roorkee. He also clarified that the courses satisfy the credit requirement of B.Tech.(CSAI) as the students belong to B.Tech.(CSAI) program.
	AAC further noted that these cases may be approved by DOAA as per the UG regulation 6.7; hence, all such cases may be put up to DOAA after the recommendation of the Department.
	The AAC concluded and approved this case.
