UG RELATED MATTERS

39.14 To discuss the proposal for allowing B.Tech students to do upto 2 extra credits of SG and CW each (deferred item from previous meeting- 37.18).

The purpose of Self Growth and Community Work activities is to put effort to develop other interest and to contribute back to society respectively. Currently B.Tech students do their mandatory 2 credits each in their 1st summer. However we see not too much interest in club activities, as well as volunteering even within the Institute. It is therefore proposed to encourage them to engage more in both of these during the rest of their program also – they really need to have a more balanced life.

Senate may kindly discuss and take appropriate decision

39.15 To discuss the proposal to convert grades for some courses to “S” in the First Year. (deferred item from previous meeting – Refer Item No. 37.19).

The UG students often face big challenge in their first year and also develop bad habits of just focusing on marks and poor practices for the same. After first year, they are often well settled. Many Institutions recognize this fact.

To help such students and provide them some room for overcoming poor performance in some courses, we may say that from the first year courses, two of their pass lowest grades may be converted to S for CGPA computation - i.e. the grade shows, but the CGPA computation does not count it. Since the record of poor grade is still there, so they cannot take it lightly.

Senate may kindly discuss and take appropriate decision.

39.16 To consider whether it should be mandatory to do the core courses in their designated slots as per UG regulations for the UG students?

Chair UGC (Dr. Anubha Gupta) will present the background of this item for discussion at the time of meeting.

39.17 Recommendation/ Report by UGC:

- 1. To consider whether Computer Networks (CSE Core course) to be included in 32 credits to be completed in last four semesters of BTech(CSE) program for completing graduation requirements.**

Chair UGC (Dr. Anubha Gupta) will present the background of this item for discussion at the time of meeting.

- 2. To consider a proposal for mandatory inclusion of additional Math course in BTech (CSE) graduation requirements.**

Chair UGC (Dr. Anubha Gupta) will present the background of this item for discussion at the time of meeting.

- 3. To consider the Branch Transfer Rules for B.Tech. Computer Science and Biosciences**

A new B.Tech. program in CS and Biosciences (CSB) has been started from the Academic year 2018-19. All our existing B.Tech. programs have provision for Branch change after first semester, a copy of the modified branch change rules approved by the Senate at its 36th meeting held on 20.9.2017 is placed at [Annexure X](#). The Head, Computational Biology vide his email dated 9th August,2018 has informed that Branch change rule applicable to other branch will also be applicable to B.Tech CSB. In case of CSB, student should have minimum grade “B” in “Introduction to programming” and “System Management”.

Senate may kindly consider the above and take appropriate decision

- 4. To consider recommendation of the UGC for grant of medical leave to UG students for availing the facility of the conduct of re-examinations of mid-sem and end-sem at a later date**

UGC at its 16th meeting held on 2nd May,2018 considered the cases of UG students submitting fake medical certificates for claiming leaves during the midsem and endsem examinations and has observed/recommended as under:

“UGC apprised members of the practice of submitting fake medical certificates by students for claiming leaves during the midsem and endsem examinations. Once medical leaves are approved, these students avail the facility of the conduct of re-examinations of mid-sem and end-sem at the later date. It was found that some students repeatedly apply medical leaves during the exams in consecutive semesters. After detailed deliberations, it was decided that only 2 medical applications would be accepted during the entire duration of their stay at IIT-D for degree completion. This is to be noted that there will not be any segregation on midsem exam, endsem exam, quiz, or any other examination related assessment component. These rules will be applicable retrospectively for all students. Also, medical certificate should be counter signed by the Parent. This will be applied on

all UG students. The same would be communicated to PGC committee for taking up for the PG students for due approval.”

The PGC at its 30th meeting held on 9th July, 2018 considered the matter and after detailed deliberations endorsed the above recommendations of the UGC and recommended for extending the same for PG students.

Senate may kindly consider and approve the above recommendations of the UGC&PGC.

5. To consider recommendation of the UGC for grant of one month extension to BTech students to complete the project based courses (BTP / IP / IS / UR)

UGC at its meeting held on 6th August,2018 has recommended for grant of one month extension to be given to BTech students to complete the project based courses (BTP / IP / IS / UR) started in any semester (Summer Term, Winter Semester, Monsoon Semester).

Senate may kindly consider and approve the above recommendation.

6. To consider recommendation of the UGC for transfer of maximum number of credits for the courses done at other university.

UGC at its meeting held on 6th August,2018 has recommended that if a student is spending a semester in some other university, and pursue some course, maximum 20 credits may be transferred to the credit pool of student's home institution.

Senate may kindly consider and approve the above recommendation.

M.TECH. RELATED MATTERS

39.18 Recommendation/ Report by PGC:

1. To consider recommendation of the PGC for (i) conversion of MTech Thesis to Scholarly Paper and vice-versa and (ii) award of regular grades for thesis credits instead of ‘S’ or ‘X’.

The PGC at its 30th meeting held on 09.07.2018 has reviewed the existing regulation for conversion of MTech Thesis to Scholarly Paper and vice-versa and made the following observations/recommendations:

“Chair PGC apprised the members of the background and the existing PG regulation. During the course of discussion regarding conversion from MTech thesis to scholarly paper, it was noted that an MTech Student registered for 16 credits for MTech Thesis but has not cleared the thesis defense. Under the circumstances the student is

required either to re-do the thesis or request for change from thesis to scholarly paper. It was also noted that the existing regulation is silent on the question of timeline for change over from thesis to scholarly paper after the thesis defense. Considering the totality of the case the PGC recommended as follow:

The request for conversion from thesis to scholarly paper may be allowed only if the student has registered and cleared upto 8 credits. If a student registers for more than 8 credits such a request shall not be permitted for conversion to scholarly paper and the student must complete the remaining credits and defend the thesis.

Arising out of discussion, the PGC recommended for award of regular grades for thesis credits instead of 'S' or 'X', except for the last 4 thesis credits, for which grade shall be awarded only after successful thesis defense. Till the time he/she is awarded grade for last 4 thesis credits, he/she will be given I grade.

If for any reason he/she still does not defend the thesis successfully, he/she will have to re-register the last 4 thesis credits.”

Senate may kindly consider and approve the above recommendations.

2. To consider the revised rules recommended by PGC for doing the Industrial Project.

The PGC at its 30th meeting held on 09.07.2018 has reviewed the existing rules for doing the Industrial Project and recommended as under:

“PGC chair apprised the members of the existing approved list of Ind Project and as the the proposal for addition of company new company KPIT in the existing list of Ind Project. During the course of discussion the members felt that the existing rules require changes to ensure that the credits earned through Industrial project (IndP) is justified. After detailed discussion the PGC recommended the following:

- i. The existing approved list shall no longer be valid for doing Ind Project.
- ii. For fresh listing of any company’s name under the approved list for Indproject , the concerned company should give its profile and consent for guiding the student and submission of 6 -10 pages report about the nature of project and the work done by the student during his/ her internship duration at the company.
- iii. The Academic section will write to students with cc to Placement cell and PGC clearly informing them that, the student can do Ind Project only in the companies which are approved by PGC. In the event the Project is done in a

company which is not approved by PGC, no credit will be given towards Ind Project.

- iv. Henceforth the credits for the Industrial Project shall be limited upto 4 credits only
- v. If a student does a project in a company which is not in the approved list of PGC no credit shall be given for the Industrial Project.”

Senate may kindly consider and approve the above recommendations.

3. To consider recommendation of the PGC for giving waiver from TA duty for PhD students who are in the 5th Year of PhD program and receiving Institute fellowship.

The PGC at its 30th meeting held on 09.07.2018 has reviewed the existing rules for TA duty for PhD students and recommended as under:

“Chair PGC apprised the members of the existing practice of assigning TA duty to Ph.D. students receiving institute fellowship and the requests for waiver being received from the students. After detailed deliberation the PGC recommended for giving waiver to Ph.D. students (getting Institute fellowship) for any two semesters. The student seeking approval for waiver shall first get the recommendation of the Advisor before forwarding the request to Academic Section.”

Senate may kindly consider and approve the above recommendations.

4. To consider recommendation of the PGC to award letter grades for MTech Thesis instead of ‘S’ or ‘X’.

The PGC at its 30th meeting held on 09.07.2018 has reviewed the existing rules for award of grades for M.Tech. thesis/SP (including Ind project and Capstone Project) and recommended as under:

“Chair PGC apprised the members of the background and the existing rules for award of ‘S’ or ‘X’ grade for M.Tech. thesis/SP(including Ind project and Capstone Project). During the course of discussions a number of options were discussed in order to improve the quality of thesis/SP. After detailed deliberation the PGC recommended to award letter grades in place of ‘S’ or ‘X’ grade as at present. For evaluation of performance in a particular semester the student shall be awarded ‘I’ or ‘F’ grade. However, the final grade awarded after the thesis defence shall replace the previous ‘I’

grades and his/her final CGPA will be calculated accordingly. The normal rules for conversion of “I” grade to regular grade will not apply to these kind of courses.”

Senate may kindly consider and approve the above recommendations.

Other proposals / Items for discussions

39.19 To consider a proposal for Encouraging women students to join IIIT-Delhi

There is a worldwide need for encouraging more women to join engineering programs. In India also, there are now attempts to increase women enrollment in IITs etc. We have been informed that TTE / Govt of Delhi also wishes to do so, and we had told them that IIIT-Delhi will try to evolve mechanisms for this.

For admissions to BTech, we have the concept of bonus marks - which are granted for a host of achievements. From last year, we have been granting some bonus marks to Delhi students who are in 99th percentile of the CBSE. For the 99th percentile, we get the cut-off from CBSE. They have indicated that they can give cutoffs separately for girls and boys.

To encourage/admit more girls, it is proposed that we shift to the following: we give bonus marks to boys who are in 99th percentile in CBSE among boys, and we give the same amount of bonus marks to girls who are in 98th percentile in CBSE. (Later, if this percentile does not achieve the desired effect, it can be further reduced.)

This method will make more girls get admission in IIIT-D, without creating a "quota" for women (which many girl students oppose). It also aligns well with our approach for giving bonus marks.

Other methods can also be discussed to encourage more girls to apply.

Senate may kindly discuss and make appropriate recommendations.

39.20 To consider nomination of members to Academic Senate . (deferred item from previous meeting – Refer Item No. 38.05).

Mr. Abhishek, a candidate for admission to B.Tech. programs through JAC 2018 has filed a writ petition before the Hon'ble Delhi High Court vide No.WP(C) 7418/2018, against the Govt. of NCT of Delhi and others alleging denial of admission due to technical fault. The NSIT who is the organising institute has called for log in details of this candidate from the NIC and the same is awaited. The next date of hearing is fixed for 6th September,2018.

MINUTES OF THE MEETING

General

38.1 Opening remarks of the Chairman.

The Chairman informed the members that there was shortage in quorum for the meeting and hence as per rules of business the meeting was required to be adjourned for sometime. Hence, after a gap for sometime the meeting was started and by that time some more members had joined the meeting. The Chairman welcomed all to the meeting. Thereafter, agenda items were taken up for discussions.

38.2 Confirmation of minutes of the 37th meeting of the Senate held on 30.01.2018

Since there were no comments, the minutes of the 37th meeting of the Senate held on 30.01.2018 were confirmed.

38.2(i) ACTION TAKEN REPORT-

Chairman, Senate apprised the members of the action taken on the various decisions taken by the Senate at its 37th meeting held on 30.01.2018. The Senate noted the position.

39.23 38.3 To report Academic calendar for Summer Semester 2018

Senate approved the Academic Calendar for Summer Term 2018 placed at [Appendix-1](#). HODs of all B.Tech. programs present at the meeting were requested to work out a 3 day module for their respective programs on the lines of 3 days module being run in the past.

39.27 38.6 To report Approval from AICTE for the Academic year 2018-19

The Senate noted with satisfaction the receipt of approval from AICTE for extension of our existing programs for the AY 2018-19 as also the approval for a new M.Tech. program "CSP". So, now the institute can pay the AICTE stipend to a total of 150 MTech students; Program-wise details are as under:

38.8 To report the status of preparation for 7th Convocation scheduled for 25th August,2018.

Chairman Senate informed that Mr. Rajan Anandan, Vice President, Google India and South East Asia has agreed to be the Chief Guest at the 7th Convocation to be held on 25th August,2018 in the forenoon. He also informed that the next meeting of the Senate will be held on 21st August, 2018 where the list of students with degree date 21st August,2018 will be placed before the Senate for approval. The Senate noted the present status of preparation for the 7th Convocation.

39.29 38.9 To report list of students completed graduation requirements on 21st May 2018.

The Senate approved the list of students who completed graduation requirements on 21st May, 2018 placed at [Appendix-III](#). Registrar was requested to check the Checklist and the transcripts of about 10% of the UG/PG students on random basis to ensure that the list is error free.

Action: Registrar and Academic Section

39.30 38.10 To report recommendations for various Awards/Medals

It was noted that selection of students for some of the awards is still in process. Hence the list will be put up to Chairman Senate for approval. The approval, so accorded, will be reported to the next meeting of the Senate for ratification.

During the course of discussions, it was noted that there are a number of challenges which cause delay in finalizing the awards, such as (i) a large number of the students and faculty are not on the campus around this time, which results in delay in scheduling presentations (ii) difficulties in scheduling M.Tech. thesis defense.

After detailed deliberations it was decided that the Advisor recommending a thesis for the Best M.Tech. thesis Award should give justifications for his/her recommendation. The matter may be taken up in PGC for discussion.

It was also decided to discuss the matter with the UGC/PGC for detailed deliberations and recommendation so that the process get smoother and these awards are announced timely instead of last moment decisions.

38.11 To report to the Senate about Increase in stipend for B.Tech. TAs

39.31 Chairman, Senate apprised the members of the recommendation of the UGC for increase in stipend for B.Tech. TAs. Chair UGC who was present at the meeting clarified the points raised by the members. After detailed deliberations, the Senate agreed to the recommendation of the UGC to have only one category of stipend and decided to increase the current stipend to Rs.6000 per month for the effort of 8 hours per week.

39.32 It was also desired by the Senate to conduct a survey among B.Tech. students to understand the efforts that UG TAs put.

4. 2018 July-Regulations for MTech in Computer Science and Engineering with specialization in Artificial Intelligence (Revised regulation was approved after clarification from the Head,CSE who was present at the meeting).

During the course of deliberations, it was observed out that ML are currently cutting across disciplines, and it may be desirable to have it available for other disciplines too. It was pointed out that this program is MTech in CSE (with specialization in AI), and hence has to follow CSE requirements. It was suggested that some other programs (e.g. CSP) may explore the possibility of making it more contemporary with suitable aspects of AI/ML added in it. The Senate requested ECE department to discuss the matter in ECE FM and come up with a proposal.

Action: HoD ECE/Academic Section

38.13 To report the summary of our graduating students/alumni gone for higher studies

and

38.14 To report the Alumni and Students who got some fellowships from a great University in AY2017-18

The Senate noted the list of graduating students/alumni gone for higher studies and those who got some fellowships, placed at Appendix IV.

38.15 To ratify the approval given by Chairman, Senate for implementation of National Academic Depository (NAD) at IIT Delhi

Chairman Senate apprised the members of the background for implementation of NationalAcademic Depository (NAD) at IIT Delhi. The Senate after a brief discussion ratified the approval given by the Chairman Senate.

38.16 To report admission of foreign nationals to B.Tech. programs under ICCR scholarship scheme

Chairman Senate apprised the members of the admission made to the supernumerary seats earmarked for foreign nationals through IIITD process. The Senate noted that the following foreign nationals have been selected for admission to B.Tech. programs under the ICCR scholarship scheme.

Chairman, Senate informed that IIT Bombay conducting the UCEED examination had expressed their inability to admit the students for IIITD. Therefore, the Senate in its 37th meeting held on 30.01.2018 vide item No.37.16 decided to admit students to B.Tech.(CSD) program only through JAC mode and discontinue admission through UCEED – the details of implementing this was left to Chairman, Senate to decide (in consultation with the admission committee). Subsequently the Chairman Senate after taking prior approval of the BoG decided to use UCEED merit ranks for admission to B.Tech.(CSD) program through IIITD process for the year 2018. The Senate ratified the decision taken by the Chairman, Senate.

The Senate noted the position and desired the PGC to discuss the current Exit Form to devise a more structured Exit Form to get the detailed inputs from the students withdrawing from the Institute. The Senate also desired that a meeting of the recently withdrawn students be arranged with HOD.

Further, it was desired to understand the early warning signs for these students till comprehensive exam. Towards this, it was felt that in the yearly evaluation, letter grades might be used instead of “S”, “X” grades. The Senate desired the PGC to discuss the matter.

38.21 To report the number of Ph.D. students on the rolls of the institute and their age-wise distribution as well as status (i.e. how many are less than 3 yrs old, list of students between 3 and 4 and their status, list of students between 4 and 5 and their status, and list of students more than 5 and their status.

A statement showing number of Ph.D. students on the rolls of the Institute, their age-wise distribution and current status was placed on the table. After detailed deliberations the Senate desired to contact all who withdrew from the Institute to know the reasons for withdrawal as well as the source of their fellowship.

38.22 To report the order of the Hon'ble Delhi High Court in the Writ Petition No.WP(C) 5412/2017, filed by Pooja Goel against the 85% reservations for Delhi school children

The Senate noted the position.

38.23 To report the order of the Hon'ble Delhi High Court in the Writ Petition No.WP(C) 5390/2017, filed by Mr. Ashwini Kumar Singh, a Diploma Holder, for admission to B.Tech. program under Lateral entry

The Senate noted the position.

38.24 To consider a proposal to review the existing Regulation for the Dual Degree Program in Computer Science and Engineering and Electronics and Communications Engineering (ECE)

Ms. Sheetu Ahuja, Manager (Academics) briefed the members about the background for the proposed revision in Clauses 2.1 and 2.2 of the Regulation for the Dual Degree program. After detailed deliberations the Senate approved the proposed revision as under:

Only students with CGPA of 7.0 or above at the time of applying are eligible for the program. The refund of fee paid towards dual degree will be regulated as per Note 3.6 of this Regulation.
2.2	Application process for dual degree will be as defined. Selection will be done as defined.	Application for Dual Degree may be invited immediately after declaration of the result of 6 th Semester. Scrutiny, selection of students, approval by Chair PGC and declaration of result to be completed by middle of June, 2018.

38.25 Reviewing the criteria for selecting the nomination for BTP awards

Chairman, Senate apprised the members of the existing criteria for evaluation of BTP and the recommendation of the UGC made in its 13th meeting held on 6th September, 2017. After detailed deliberations the Senate agreed to the following recommendation:

All BTPs in the following three categories be forwarded to the Committee for consideration:

- a. All A+ Grades
- b. All A grades
- c. All Popular Votes

Arising out of the discussion, the Senate desired to review the existing criteria again in the UGC to exclude students with “A” grade and consider only A+ grades or popular ones.

38.26 To consider the recommendations of the UGC for approval of Regulations for (i) Minor in Economics and (ii) Minor in Computational Biology

Chairman Senate apprised members of the existing regulations for (i) Minor in Economics and (ii) Minor in Computational Biology and the recommendations made by the UGC at its 16th meeting held on 2nd May, 2018 . After detailed deliberations the Senate approved the revised Regulations placed at [Appendix-V](#) and [Appendix-VI](#), after making a minor change in the effective date for Minor in Economics.

(Note 1 of the existing revised regulation provides: “The regulations for Minor in Economics are applicable for students who commenced their B.Tech. program in the year 2015 or later years”- hence it should be changed to 2016 or later years)

The Senate considered the recommendation of the PGC regarding the criteria for issuing Academic Warning to M.Tech. students and agreed to the following recommendation
“Students will be placed on Academic Warning if their SGPA/CGPA at the end of a semester falls below 6”.

38.29 To consider the recommendations of the PGC regarding counting of grades of Refresher Module (in summer) towards CGPA of M.Tech. Students.

Senate agreed to the below recommendation of the PGC

“The grades for Refresher module offered in Summer should reflect in the transcript without counting the grades towards calculation of CGPA and credits for these courses towards the degree requirement”

Action: Academic Section

38.30 To consider a proposal to add courses to Environmental Sciences (EVS) Bucket for UG students.

The Senate discussed the currently running compulsory 2 cr Environmental Sciences Course for B.Tech. students and the proposal to add more such courses to the EVS bucket which can satisfy this requirement and students will be required to do any one of the courses offered in this bucket. After detailed deliberations the Senate agreed to the proposal.

Regulations for Minor in Economics

Minor Program:

A BTech student can earn a minor certification in economics by completing a total of 20 credits from economics courses. Of these, 16 credits must be earned by completing regular courses while remaining 4 credits may be earned by completing additional coursework or by completing independent study (IS), undergraduate research (UR), or independent project (IP). The minor program is designed to impart basic training in microeconomics, game theory, and econometrics. Students interested in specific areas of interest for which a formal course is not offered may opt for independent with individual faculty.

Courses:

In order to earn a Minor in Economics, a student must complete the core courses and complete the remaining credits by choosing the electives offered from Economics, Management or Finance.

Core Courses for a Minor in Economics: Microeconomics, Game Theory and Econometrics I.

Benchmarking: Economics-minor programs at North American and Indian universities typically require six courses in economics, including *Probability and Statistics*, which all BTech students take in 1st year. Thus, the proposed 20-credit program is standard.

39.33 Regulation for Minor in Computational Biology (CB)

Minor Program: A BTech student can earn a minor certification in computational biology by completing 16 credits of regular courses, and further 4 credits through additional coursework, independent study (IS), undergraduate research (UR), or independent project (IP), or 8 credits of BTP on a core Computational Biology topic, with prior approval by CB UG Coordinator, for a cumulative 20/24 credits in Computational Biology. The program is intended to be complementary to CSE/ECE/CSAM/CSD/CSSS, and emphasizes on the foundations of cell and molecular biology, biochemistry, genetics, mathematical biology, systems biology and computational genomics. Students pursuing BTech in CSB cannot opt for a Minor in Computational Biology.

Courses: All courses are for 4 credits, except IQB, and require 3rd year standing or higher.

1. *Introduction to Quantitative Biology (IQB)*: Foundation course consisting of fundamental aspects of cellular and molecular studied by quantitative approaches as well as simple mathematical/statistical and computational tools.
2. Any 3 BIO-numbered (3xx to 6xx) course (except FOMB/IP/IS/UR/BTP/BIOX71—BIOX80) as long as pre-requisites are fulfilled.

Core Courses: IQB, listed above, is mandatory for the minor degree.

Recommended sequence of courses: IQB is recommended as the first course for the minor in computational biology.

J. Some anomalies during admission process

JAC

1. Under the JAC admission process, after closing of sixth round, internal upgradation is run for the admitted students only. Due to bonus marks of IIITD and women only institution i.e IGDTUW upgradation is restricted to certain closing ranks. This year the committee decided to put this cutoff for upgradation at maximum rank of DTU, NSIT and IIITD. However, this was not implemented properly at NIC, due to which some candidates despite of having better IIITD rank were not considered for internal upgradation. The matter was reported to JAC, however they decided not to take any action and proceeded with the Spot Round.

2. During spot round conversion of vacant seats from ST to SC category, due to some technical glitches around 8 students were admitted in excess in SCGND category. In IIITD 2 students were admitted in excess in CSSS program. Since the matter was brought to the notice after the admission of the students, JAC requested all the institutes to admit the students over and above the mentioned approved seats. The matter was taken up with the Director and the Chairman and approval was accorded for the same.

Branch Change Rules for B.Tech (CSE,ECE,CSAM,CSD,ITSS)

Transfer of B.Tech. students from one program to the other is possible only after the grades of the first semester are out. This is the only time branch change will occur. A student must make an explicit request to be considered for program transfer. In his/her request, the student can mention more than one program in the order of preference. Rules for program transfer are:

1. Only the students who satisfy eligibility for a particular branch at the time of admission are eligible for transfer to that branch.
2. Students admitted through AICTE need to produce NOC from AICTE if applying for transfer to another program.
3. Students must have passed all credits specified for the first semester of the B.Tech. program.
4. To be eligible for transfer to Computer Science and Engineering (CSE) program, a student must have received a B or better grade in both CSE courses of the first year, namely, Introduction to Programming, and System Management
5. To be eligible for transfer to Electronics and Communication Engineering (ECE) program, a student must have received a B or better grade in both Digital Circuits and Maths I.
6. To be eligible for transfer to Computer Science and Applied Mathematics (CSAM) or Computer Science and Design (CSD) program or Information Technology and Social Sciences (ITSS)program , a student must have received a B or better grade in Introduction to Programing and Math I
7. The students eligible for program transfer will be ordered in a priority list based on CGPA, and will be granted transfer in order as long as the strength of each program does not violate the following limits.
8. The base strength of a program for a batch will be the number of students who were admitted and who are still enrolled in the program as on Dec 15 (after Sem 1) after completion of one semester, not counting those who were repeating the first year. (E.g. Suppose 110 students were admitted in a batch (and there were 8 repeaters.) If 6 of the admitted students dropped out before Dec 15, then the base strength will be $110-6=104$) The final strength of any program shall not reduce by more than 10% of its base strength. Also, the final strength of any program shall not increase by more than 10% of its base strength.
9. Repeaters who are repeating fist year are allowed to do so under the above mentioned rules
