**MINUTES OF THE MEETING**

**41.1 WELCOME AND OPENING REMARKS BY THE CHAIRPERSON**

The Chairman welcomed all to the meeting.

On behalf of the Senate of the Institute, the Chairman conveyed sincere thanks to all the outgoing Senate members for their valuable contributions made during their tenure, which were extremely useful for evolving the right policies and maintain standard of education at the Institute and hoped to get their continued support and cooperation in times to come.

The Chairman also welcomed the new Senate members and hoped to receive their valuable contributions in evolving the right policies to maintain standards of education at the Institute.

Chairman, Senate also informed that the Senate in its 40<sup>th</sup> meeting vide item No. 40.10 had authorized him to finalize nominations for the Academic Senate and subsequently place in the Senate meeting for ratification. Accordingly, a total of 40 new members (30 IIITD faculty + 8 external members + 2 alumni) are nominated to the Academic Senate and their names are shown in the list under new members of [Appendix I](#). As per the approved composition, Registrar is the non-voting Secretary of the Senate. Student Representative(s) attend the meetings as special invitee(s). The Senate ratified the above nominations to the Academic Senate.

Thereafter, agenda items were taken up for discussions.

**41.2 CONFIRMATION OF MINUTES OF THE 40<sup>TH</sup> MEETING OF THE SENATE HELD ON 20.11.2018**

Except for the observation to item No. 40.13, no other comments were received. Therefore, the minutes of the 40<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Senate held on 20<sup>th</sup> November, 2018 except item no. 40.13, were confirmed.

As regards the observation to Item No. 40.13, Dr. Anubha Gupta, ADOAA presented this item and informed that the curriculum of all programs of IIIT-D had been framed after a number of deliberations and workshops with external domain experts. Since this item is related to curriculum change of the UG regulations, it needs an in-depth discussion with domain experts. It was noted that CSAM and CSSS departments are already considering to review their curriculum based on their experience of 2.5 years and 1.5 years, respectively. After detailed deliberations, Senate agreed not to implement the proposed changes of curriculum to UG regulations, earlier agreed on 20<sup>th</sup> November 2018. It was agreed that the existing UG regulations will prevail and the changes suggested in the meeting of 20<sup>th</sup> November 2018 should come through the process of curriculum change via in-depth discussions with internal and external domain experts. Hence, decision taken vide item No. 40.13 of the minutes of the 40<sup>th</sup> Senate meeting stands withdrawn.

### 41.3 ACTION TAKEN REPORT

Chairman, Senate apprised the members of the action taken on the various decisions taken by the Senate in its 40<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 20<sup>th</sup> November, 2018. The Senate noted the position. With regard to awarding bonus marks to encourage women students to join IIITD, it was noted that the legal opinion sought by the Institute has been received from the Advocate. However, despite the written and telephonic reminders send by Prof. Pankaj Jalote (founding Director) the required data from CBSE is still awaited. After detailed deliberations the Senate therefore, decided to continue with the bonus marks for class XII as was done in the last year. The process of making any change may be considered after the data from the CBSE is received and discussed.

##### 41.4.1.1 To consider the End of Semester Summary Report (Monsoon 2018)

Dr. Gaurav Arora, UG Chair, presented the summary of various activities of academics undertaken in the previous semester (Monsoon 2018) including performance of UG/PG/Ph.D. The semester summary was earlier reviewed by a committee of UG Chair, PG Chair and DoAA. The committee came up with the below observations.

The Senate further authorized the Director (Chairman, Senate) to add more names of experts in future, if and when required.

### 41.5 ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION AND CONSIDERATION

#### 41.5.1 *B.Tech. related matters*

##### 41.5.1.1 To review the existing Branch Transfer Rule for B.Tech. CSE

Dr. Anubha Gupta, ADOAA apprised the members of the earlier discussions held in its 39<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 21<sup>st</sup> August, 2018 and the recommendations made by FM of the Deptt. of CSE and subsequently by the UGC (20<sup>th</sup> Meeting) that SM course grade should not be counted for branch transfer to B.Tech(CSE). Instead Math-1 (along with IP) should be considered. She also informed that with this change, the below tie breaking rules should be followed for the students with the same CGPA for transfer to B.Tech(CSE) Program:

**Tie Breaking Rule I** - For transfer to CSE branch, higher grade in the order of IP, Maths I, SM, DC, Comm

**Tie Breaking Rule II** -Higher JEE Rank

After detailed deliberations, the Senate approved the above new Branch Transfer Rule for B.Tech. CSE and the new Tie breaking rules.

During the course of discussions Dr. Aman Parnami pointed out as to why the Design Course should also not be included in the 1<sup>st</sup> Semester for the purpose of branch transfer. After a brief discussion, it was decided to refer the matter to the UGC for larger discussions for any possible change in the existing Branch Transfer Rules.

**41.5.1.2 To consider recommendation of the UGC for allowing senior B.Tech. students to take two 2xx level courses.**

Dr. Anubha Gupta, ADOAA presented the background of the proposal. After a brief discussion, the Senate agreed to the recommendation of the UGC made in its 20<sup>th</sup> Meeting to allow B.Tech. 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> year students to do two 2xx level courses. It was also agreed that if the courses are of the respective department, it will satisfy the 32 credit requirement.

**41.5.1.3 Criteria for admission of Foreign Nationals through IIITD admission process.**

Dr. Anubha Gupta, ADOAA presented the background of the proposal. During the course of discussions the members made various suggestions for helping the foreign nationals coming from different backgrounds. After detailed deliberations, the Senate did not agree to the recommendation of the UGC for making TOFEL/IELETS compulsory for students coming through foreign national category. The Senate decided that to assess the ability of students in understanding and communicating in English, the committee should interview the applicants. The Senate also recommended that UGC should discuss how to help such students who face challenges in understanding/speaking English by exploring the options of opening a writing lab, adding listening component in the Communication Skills course, etc.

**41.5.2 *Ph.D. related matters***

**41.5.2.1 To reconsider the special requirements for Ph.D. in Social Sciences and Humanities**

Dr. Gaurav Arora apprised the members of the discussions held in earlier Senate meetings, i.e., its 37<sup>th</sup> meeting and 40<sup>th</sup> Meeting, and informed that after incorporating the changes the SSH Department submitted the modified document containing special requirements for Ph.D. program in Social Sciences and Humanities in the areas of Economics and Sociology/Anthropology and the same has been examined by a committee comprising of UG Chair (also faculty member, SSH), PG Chair, DoAA, Head (SSH), Dr Vigneswara, external expert in the area of SSH and Prof Dheeraj Sanghi, external expert in CSE. After detailed deliberations, the Senate approved the modified document placed at [Appendix VI](#)

The Senate also approved the change in the name of the program from PhD in Social Sciences to PhD in Social Sciences and Humanities.

### **41.5.3 Other Matters**

#### **41.5.3.1 Admission to B.Tech Program under PMSS scholarship scheme of AICTE for J&K students.**

As per the recent scheme of AICTE for admission to B.Tech Program under PMSS scholarship scheme, each Institute can admit upto 10 candidates. However, the fee for each candidate will be maximum Rs 1.25 L per annum. The student will be given maintenance allowance of Rs 1L. Since, fee for IITD candidates is proposed to be raised to Rs 2.75L per annum from academic year 2019-20 and the AICTE rules strictly prohibit charging of fee over and above Rs 1.25 L from the student, the B.Tech Admission committee has proposed not to participate in the admission process under the above scheme. After a brief discussion the Senate agreed and recommended the above proposal to the Board.

#### **41.5.3.2 To consider the request of an M.Tech. student for continuation of registration.**

Dr. Anubha Gupta, ADOAA apprised the members of the background of the case of Mr. Moulik Dayal, Roll No. MT17029. She informed that based on the performance in the first semester, he was issued a warning. Subsequently, he was also issued termination after 2<sup>nd</sup> semester due to poor performance. However, on his request, he was allowed to continue. After the 3<sup>rd</sup> semester, his performance has still remained below the required CGPA. He has again requested to continue his studies. It was noted that till 3<sup>rd</sup> semester, he has completed a total of 28 credits of course work out of 48 credits and is also left with Thesis/SP. He has completed 8 credits of mandatory course. His current CGPA is 5.22 against the minimum graduating CGPA of 6.5. After detailed deliberations, the Senate did not agree to his request for continuation of his registration.

#### **41.5.3.3 To consider the matter discussed in 39<sup>th</sup> Senate regarding Bonus marks to Women Students.**

The BoG in its 42<sup>nd</sup> meeting had desired to collect data from CBSE from the previous year about how many girls will fall in different percentiles – absolute, as well as for percentiles separately for girls and boys/rest (it was felt that it should be explored whether it is better to define percentile cutoffs for girls and boys/others based on their population only) and seeking legal opinion to go on with such proposal. While we have received the legal opinion, the data from CBSE is still awaited. Since the admission process is about to start, it is proposed that we should continue with the Bonus Marks for Class XII marks as in the past. After detailed deliberation, the Senate agreed to the proposal and recommended to continue with the Bonus Marks for Class XII marks as in the past.

## Special requirements for PhD in Social Sciences and Humanities

Page 3-4:

Eligibility and Admission Criteria: (Discipline-wise requirements)

### **Economics:**

*Application Eligibility:*

MA/MSc/MPhil in Economics, Statistics, Mathematics or basic sciences

BTech/MTech. in any discipline and/or MBA.

Students applying with MA/MSc/MPhil need to have secured at least second division (at least 50% marks or 5.5 CGPA on a scale of 10).

Students applying with BTech/MTech need to have secured at least 70% marks or 7.5 CGPA on a scale of 10

Students applying with MBA need to have secured at least 70% marks or 3.0 CGPA on a scale of 4.

*Entrance test and Interviews:*

Eligible candidates will be invited to write an entrance examination that will test the candidate's foundational knowledge in intermediate economics.

Short-listed candidates from entrance exam stage will be interviewed by an expert committee and the final decision on the admission will be made based on the candidate's overall performance.

Candidates applying for PhD in Economics should submit a 2-page statement of purpose (SoP) delineating research theme(s) within Economics that may include specific questions of potential research interest to the candidate. The candidate is expected to clearly express his/her interest in the outlined research theme(s) or questions to the extent possible.

### **Sociology/Anthropology:**

*Application Eligibility:*

MA/MSc/ MPhil in Sociology, Anthropology, Political Science, Development Studies or any other related Social Sciences discipline.

BTech/MTech. in any discipline and/or MBA/MSW.

Students applying with MA/MSc/MPhil/MSW need to have secured at least second division (at least 50% marks or 5.5 CGPA on a scale of 10).

Students applying with BTech/MTech need to have secured at least 70% marks or 7.5 CGPA on a scale of 10

Students applying with MBA need to have secured at least 70% marks or 3.0 CGPA on a scale of 4.

*Entrance test and Interviews:*

Eligible candidates will be invited to write an entrance examination that will test the candidate's knowledge in foundational Sociology and Anthropology topics.



Short-listed candidates from the entrance examination stage will be interviewed by an expert committee and the final decision on the admission will be made based on the candidate's overall performance.

Candidates applying for Ph.D. in Sociology/Anthropology should submit a 2-page statement of purpose (SoP) delineating research theme(s) within Sociology/Anthropology that may include specific questions of potential research interest to the candidate when applying. The candidate is expected to clearly express his/her interest in the outlined research theme(s) or questions to the extent possible.

Preference will be given to those with a post-graduate degree in Sociology/Anthropology. Preference will also be given to those who have cleared either NET/JRF or SLET.

**Page 6:**  
**Change from One Program to Another**

The institute does not currently offers Masters program in any of the Social Science disciplines. Therefore, in scenarios where a student fails his or her comprehensive exam or the PhD thesis is not found suitable migration to a different program is not possible.

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**Coursework requirement:**

PhD students will be required to complete 32 credits of PhD level coursework. Students who enter after an MPhil will need to complete a minimum of 24 credits (implying a waiver of maximum 8 credits). This waiver in coursework may only be provided with the permission from the thesis advisor and the dissertation committee.

In addition, students are required to complete 56 research credits.

500-level courses (or higher) will be considered towards the PhD program. However, students may be allowed to take at most two advanced undergraduate courses (300-level or higher) with the permission of the thesis advisor and PGC.

Maximum of 2 Independent Study courses are allowed to be counted towards PhD credits. Independent Project credits are disallowed for PhD program in Social Sciences and Humanities disciplines.

**Sociology/Anthropology:** Specialized coursework in addition to the general requirements above)

Students are expected to compulsorily take three courses - Research Methods in Sociology/Anthropology, Theories in Sociology/Anthropology and Sociology/Anthropology of India worth 12 credits in total. Once these courses are offered within the department, the expectation is that these courses are only taken with the department and cannot be substituted for credits if taken elsewhere.

The total of 32 course credits will be divided as 16 credits for Courses and 16 credits for PhD level research seminar style classes (where research papers are intensively discussed by the course instructor).

Students are encouraged to actively audit any related courses other than those expected for credit coursework with the permission of the thesis adviser.

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## Comprehensive Exam

### **Economics**

Time limit for completion of comprehensive exam is 4 semesters, irrespective of the students' background. In special cases one semester extension may be provided with a maximum of two attempts with permission from the thesis advisor and PGC. Students with an MPhil degree may be allowed to attempt the comprehensive exam after the completion of three semesters.

### **Sociology/Anthropology**

Time limit for completion of comprehensive exam is 3 semesters, irrespective of the students' background. In special cases, one semester extension may be provided with a maximum of two attempts with permission from the thesis advisor and PGC.

Before the student finally defends his/her thesis for PhD in Sociology/Anthropology, the student is expected to have published in well reputed national/international journals and presented at well reputed national/international conferences. In case of book chapters, the expectation is to have published them with well-reputed international publishers such as Sage/Wiley etc. The thesis advisor and the PGC will judge the nature and the prestige of the conferences/book publishers.

### **Clarification notes:**

In order to comply with the CGPA requirement for continuing in the PhD program (item 12.2 under 'Minimum Academic Performance Requirements') coursework grades will be mapped from the course granting institution into IIT-Delhi grades depending on the subject area and the course granting institution. Students must secure the minimum grade requirement in order to continue in the PhD program. In the event that a student does not fulfil these requirements, it shall be up to the discretion of the departmental committee to decide on the further continuance of the student in the PhD program, followed by a formal approval of the PGC.
