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FORTY-FIFTH (45th) MEETING OF THE SENATE OF IIIT-DELHI (HELD ON FEBRUARY 13, 2020)

MINUTES OF THE MEETING

45.1 WELCOME AND OPENING REMARKS BY THE CHAIRPERSON

The Chairman welcomed all to the meeting. Thereafter, agenda items were taken up for discussions.

45.2 CONFIRMATION OF MINUTES OF THE 44th MEETING OF THE SENATEHELD ON NOVEMBER 13, 2019

No comments were received on the minutes of the 44th meeting of the Senate held on November 13, 2019. Hence, the minutes of the meeting were confirmed.

45.3 ACTION TAKEN REPORT

The Chairman, Senate apprised the members of the action taken on the various decisions taken by the Senate in its 44th meeting held on November 13, 2019. The Senate noted the position.

45.4 ITEMS FOR INFORMATION/ RATIFICATION

45.4.1 General Matters

45.4.1.1To report End of Semester Summary Report (Monsoon 2019)

Dean of Academic Affairs presented the Semester Summary Report. She also answered the queries raised by the members during the course of deliberations. The Senate noted the position and approved the Semester Summary Report placed at <u>Appendix I</u> with the following suggestions/observations:

- i. To find out if there exists any correlation between the attendance and the performance and present the outcome in the next meeting of the Senate. More details should be provided in terms of specific metrics/percentages.
- ii. To show the pattern of attendance in other courses
- iii. TLC should look into this issue of attendance and come up with suggestions to improve the same
- iv. The time table should be looked into the class timings may be a factor i.e. where/when the classes are being held
- v. In the course having both lectures and labs, some students attend the labs but fewer number of students are present in the lecture classes
- vi. To evolve better ways to inform the parents regarding the attendance and performance. The possibility of informing parents through SMS to be looked into.
- vii. Semester Summary Report document is very large and difficult for the members to go through and draw conclusion in the meeting. Hence, it was suggested to change the format of the Semester Summary report and present the data in a manner such that broad trends could be visualized/analyzed.

45.4.1.8 To report the release of the updated PG and Dual Degree Regulations

DOAA informed that the changes approved in recent meetings of the Senate with regards to PG and Dual-degree Regulations have been incorporated in the respective Regulations and will be finalized soon. After a brief discussion, the Senate authorized the Chairman, Senate to approve these changes before the release of the same for the website.

45.5 ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION AND CONSIDERATION

45.5.1 UG related matters

45.5.1.1 To consider to put on hold the decision regarding allowing registrations for substantially reduced credits (only 4) in one of the semesters to B.Tech. students.

Dr. Sankha S. Basu, Chair UGC presented this item and apprised the members of the earlier decision taken by the Senate during its 40th meeting held on November 20, 2018 allowing B.Tech. students an under load up to a maximum of 4 credits only in one semester. He also apprised the members of the subsequent discussions in the 36th meeting of the UGC held on December 16, 2019 where the UGC, after detailed deliberations, requested the departments to discuss and come up with the criteria for allowing students to register for as low as 4 credits in one of the semester and suggested to put the decision on hold till the time the criteria is decided. Dr. Sankha also clarified the points raised by the members.

During the course of deliberations some members expressed concern that the decision to allow students of some departments in 3rd and 4th year and to some in the 8th semester only is discriminatory because all the programs should be given equal treatment. Some of the members were also opposed to the idea of putting the earlier decision on hold.

The external members from IIT Delhi informed that the students in their Institute are allowed only in 7th - 8th Semester with the permission of the Departments.

The DOAA also informed the members that based on the concerns raised the matter was discussed in the HoD's meeting and it was suggested to prepare a proper criterion.

Dr. Shobha Sundar Ram, Head, ECE department raised the issue of a total ban on M.Tech. Internships. She pointed out that the Senate in its minutes of the 43rd meeting held on July 17,2019 has referred to the recommendations of the 33rd meeting of the PGC held on 23.1.2019 but the PGC did not recommend a ban on Internships. Similarly, there is no recommendation for a total ban in the minutes of the 39th PGC held on 15.7.2019. Therefore, the decision taken by the Senate to ban Internship needs to be reviewed.

After protracted discussions, the Senate requested the Chair PGC to discuss the ban on Internships in the PGC and formulate a policy, to be placed on the table during the next Senate meeting.

45.5.1.2To consider a proposal for starting a Minor in Entrepreneurship for B.Tech. students

The Chair UGC presented the proposal for starting a Minor in Entrepreneurship (ENT) for B.Tech. students and apprised the members of the recommendations made by the UGC at its 37th meeting held on January 29, 2020. Thereafter, Prof. Ponnurangam Kumaraguru made a detailed presentations and explained the complete program structure for offering a Minor in ENT. After detailed discussions, the Senate approved the proposal for a Minor in Entrepreneurship (ENT) to be started from Summer 2020. All the proposed courses will be given appropriate course numbers and the SSH Department will be the owner of this program. The Senate also desired that the suggestions of some of the members be looked into, such as IP issues, the possibility of fractal credit courses of 1 or 2 credits as being done at IIT Delhi (similar to SG & CW), giving fellowships to students for staying-on for an additional year (pre-entrepreneurship) and framing the Regulation for the Minor in ENT. The final Regulation, along with the revised proposal, may then be

submitted to Chairman, Senate who was authorized to approve on behalf of the Senate and implement it from 2019 B.Tech. batch onwards.

45.5.2 PG related matters

45.5.2.1 To consider the recommendation of the PGC regarding the provision for having an internal examiner for evaluation of a Ph.D. Thesis

The Chair PGC presented this item and apprised the members of the decision taken by the Senate at its 44th meeting held on November 13, 2019 regarding the removal of the provision for having an internal examiner for evaluation of a Ph.D. thesis. He also informed that the matter was subsequently discussed in the PGC at its 44th meeting held on January 29, 2020 and recommended as under:

"Chair PGC briefed the PGC members regarding the decision of 44th Senate meeting on the recommendation of the PGC for the removal of the provision for having an internal examiner for the evaluation of a Ph.D. thesis. After detailed deliberations, the PGC agreed to the recommendation of the Senate for no change in the current Ph.D. thesis guidelines regarding appointment of internal examiner for Ph.D. thesis evaluation. The PGC has also recommended that appointment of an internal examiner for thesis evaluation will be processed by Post Graduate Committee."

After a brief discussion and clarification from the Chair PGC, the Senate approved the above recommendation of the PGC.

45.5.2.2 To consider the recommendation of the PGC for minor modification in the Clause 11 (4) c of the PG Regulations.

The Chair PGC informed that the PGC at its 44^{th} meeting held on January 29, 2020 noted some ambiguity in Clause 11 (4) c and d of the existing PG Regulations which needs correction. Hence, the PGC recommended to remove the word "SGPA" from Clause 11 (4) c.

The Senate approved the above recommendation of the PGC.

45.5.3 Other Matters

45.5.3.1 To consider and approve the Academic Calendars for Monsoon 2020 and Winter 2021: Proposal to delay the start date of both the semesters by about 20-22 days compared to the one practiced otherwise

The Dean of Academic Affairs presented the proposal for new Academic Calendars for Monsoon 2020 and Winter 2021. She informed that currently, the semester start dates for Monsoon and Winter Semesters are 1st (working day) of August and 1st (working day) of January, respectively. She also apprised the members of the feedback received from some of the faculty members on the new calendars proposed. The modified calendars

have been prepared after discussions with the various stake holders and this will help the Institute in multiple ways as detailed in the agenda note.

During the course of deliberations Prof. Anand Srivastava and Dr. Vivek Bohara raised a concern on the proposed modification in the time table. They informed that IEEE ANTS is scheduled to be held in IIIT Delhi from 14th till 18th December, 2020 and these dates were finalized long time ago considering the fact that December is vacation time and classrooms and the hostels will be available for the delegates (from India and abroad). For the smooth conduct of the conference they would need at least 2 large lecture halls (500 and 250 seater capacity for keynotes), multiple small classrooms (60-100 seaters for technical sessions), apart from hostel rooms, guest houses etc.

Some members suggested to hold the conference outside the campus in order to avoid changes in the proposed calendars but the suggestion was opposed on the plea that it will involve cost for which there is no provision in the budget. Besides, the Institute with its excellent infrastructural facilities, will also not get highlighted among the participants.

The student representatives present during the meeting also expressed their views and supported the calendars which provide longer recess and sufficient gap during the examination days.

Some members suggested to have the provision for recess after the exam days. It was also suggested to have the seating arrangement during the examination in such a way that the students sitting on adjacent seats will either have different sets of question papers or different subjects. This is likely to reduce the number of days set aside for exams to some extent.

During the deliberations, the DOAA clarified the points raised by the members. After detailed deliberations, the Senate, in principle, agreed to delay the start of both the semesters. The Monsoon semester could start after 15th August and the Winter Semester after 15th January (i.e. a shift in the calendar by 15 days). The following suggestions were also made:

- The mid recess could be immediately after the mid semester exams in both the semesters
- To explore reducing the number of days set aside for the exams by merging the seating arrangements for two different courses.
- In order to facilitate the IEEE ANTS conference, while preparing for the examination schedule of Monsoon 2020 semester, the core courses may be scheduled on early days so that big lectures halls could be provided for the conference.

The Senate further desired that another version of the Academic calendar for both the semesters may be prepared showing the changes, including the revised examination schedule. Dr. Vivek Bohara was requested to intimate the requirements for the conference expeditiously with details so that the necessary adjustment in the calendar could be worked out suitably.

45.5.3.2 To consider request of Mr. Viraj Rokade (Roll No.MT 18240) for continuation of his M.Tech. registration

The Chair PGC presented the case of Mr. Viraj Rokade (Roll No.MT 18240) who was allowed to register in 3rd semester (Monsoon 2019) with a clear stipulation that in the event of failure to maintain the minimum required CGPA/SGPA in the 3rd semester, the registration shall be liable for termination. Since he failed to maintain the required CGPA/SGPA, despite the assurance given by him, his registration for M.Tech. program was terminated vide notification No. IIITD/Acad/2020/2443 dated January 29, 2020.

The Chair PGC further informed that Mr. Viraj Rokade vide his appeal dated 5.2.2020 while admitting his mistakes, has requested to reconsider his case and not to terminate his M.Tech. (CB) program. The matter was referred/circulated to the counselor and the PGC, respectively. Considering that his mental state is getting better which helped him to improve his academic performance, both the Counselor and the PGC have recommended to allow the student to continue with his studies. After detailed deliberations, the Senate accepted his appeal and decided to allow him to continue with his studies.

45.5.3.3 To ratify the approval given by the Chairman, Senate to allow Aryman Dhobal, a fourth year B.Tech. student to replace ADA with Introduction to Graduate Algorithms (IGA)

The case of Aryaman Dhobal, Roll No. 2015016, a fourth year B.Tech. CSE student who had failed the core course: Algorithm Design and Analysis (ADA) for the first time in Winter 2019 was presented before the Senate. It was submitted that the student mis-read the Regulation thinking that he can replace this core course with another elective even though he had only failed once. As per B.Tech. Regulations, one core course can be replaced by an elective after failing twice in the same course. After detailed deliberations, the Senate ratified the approval given by the Chairman, Senate to allow Aryaman Dhobal to replace ADA with Introduction to Graduate Algorithms (IGA) with a note that students are supposed to be aware of the rules governing their programs. Also, this permission may not be cited as a precedent in future.

45.5.3.4 To report the status of NBA accreditation of B.Tech. (ECE) program

The DOAA informed that the National Board of Accreditation (NBA) vide letter File No.17-25-2013-NBA dated 31.01.2020 has conveyed the approval of the NBA for accreditation of UG program in Electronics and Communications Engineering for the Academic Years 2019-20 to 2021-22, i.e. for 3 years up to 30.06.2022. The Senate noted the same with satisfaction.

45.5.3.5 To consider a proposal for making BTP optional in the B.Tech. (CSD) program

Dr. Aman Parnami, representing the Human Centered Design (HCD) Department presented the proposal for making BTP optional in the B.Tech. (CSD) program. It was noted that B.Tech. (CSD) program which was started in 2017 has requirement of compulsory BTP of 8-12 credits. The proposal was considered by the UGC in its 33rd meeting held on 27.9.2019 and the UGC had desired the HCD department to deliberate in the light of the discussions held at the meeting and bring the matter back to the UGC.

Subsequently, after getting the input from the department, the UGC at its 36th meeting held on 16.12.2019 further considered the proposal and made the following observations/recommendations:

"One of the UGC member informed that as per regulations B.Tech. Project is a mandatory requirement for CSD department. Rationale behind making BTP mandatory was that when CSD program was started department did not exist, at that time understanding was that department will be requiring Design students to attain practical and applied/hands-on knowledge in Design, which they will be taught in 1st and 2nd year.

However, after the department started rolling out courses in past 2 years, the department has ensured that almost every course has a strong project component meaning that by the time they reach 5th semester CSD first batch students have already done 5 projects with design applications, which was the primary reason for making BTPs mandatory. Given that the students already have a lot of projects to gain practical knowledge, the department feels that students should be able to take up advanced skill-based courses.

With this rationale department wants to strongly propose that B.Tech. project should now be optional to CSD students so that students can choose courses as per their choice and by that department will be satisfied that they are able to cover both skill based and project based learning for students.

UGC CSD coordinator also informed that CSD department had a detailed discussion including every course we are running in Design department with 3 external experts who visited IIITD from Georgia Tech, Washington U and CMU recently. Those experts belong to Universities that run the best Design programs globally. These experts were also of the view that students are already doing enough projects through their classroom learning that making BTPs optional should be fine.

UGC members discussed and were in favour of the department's view on the matter. The committee, however, observed that since BTPs are a part of graduation requirement, any change would not be an operational change and outside the purview of the UGC. It needs discussion and approval from Senate. For that, the department is requested to furnish the minutes of the discussions held with external experts and their recommendations.

One of the UGC member suggested that if this change in curriculum (i.e. BTP to be optional for CSD students) gets approved from Senate then it will not be applicable to the students who are currently doing BTP (2017 batch). It can be made

applicable to the students who are in II year right now and will be taking B.Tech. Projects from III year onwards (2018 batch)."

The HCD department has provided the minutes of the meeting (MOM) with Symposium Experts held on December 14, 2019 placed at <u>Appendix IV</u>

Dr. Aman Parnami, who presented the proposal, also clarified and answered the queries made by the members during the course of the discussions. Some members suggested to compare the project work with other programs, as well as, to take feedback from the instructors teaching the courses to understand the project components. After detailed deliberations, the Senate agreed to the recommendation of the UGC to make BTP optional in the B.Tech. (CSD) program. It will be applicable to the students who are in IInd year right now and will be taking B.Tech Projects from IIIrd year onwards (2018 batch).

Action: Academic Section

45.5.3.6 To consider the nomination of members to Academic Senate

The Chairman, Senate apprised the members of the tenure of the existing nominated Senate members and the requirement for fresh nominations for the next year. After a brief discussion, the Senate authorized the Chairman, Senate to finalize/approve nominations to the Senate and the same may subsequently be reported for information. However, till the nomination of new members are finalized and approved, the Senate agreed to extend the tenure of the existing nominated members.
